What

Timelines at the NICC describe the historic milestones of a narrative, bilateral cooperation or any other international cooperation and development project. They are our main vessels to provide information to anyone interested and to create interest. A timeline itself gets created by interviewing relevant experts and consulting various information sources. The larger effort surrounding timeline creation also includes planning meetings, coordination within the organisation and promoting timelines or topics via social media or via webinars. In short, it requires (but also offers the opportunity to learn!) a variety of different skills. We are specifically looking for someone to help construct our new timeline on sustainable water management and rainwater harvesting.

When/where

We are offering an internship for a 4 month period (starting anywhere between June and October, open to negotiation). Where you can contribute, in a variety of ways, to the creation and promotion of our timelines. The offices are based in Den Haag. However due to Covid-19 restrictions all work will be done online at least until restrictions loosen up.
